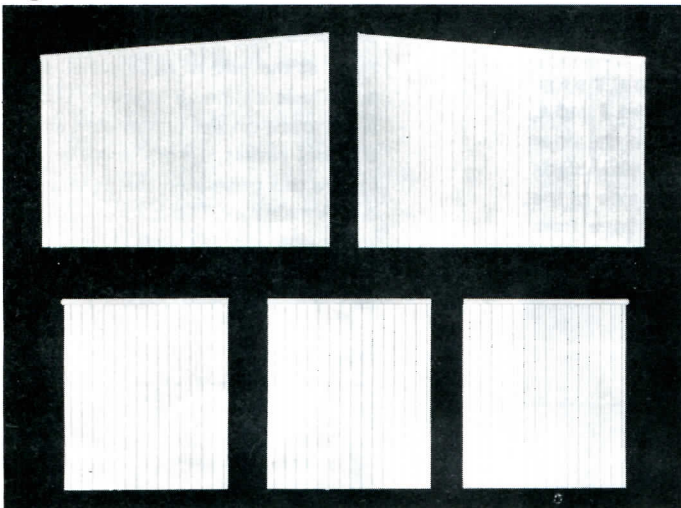


Pikestuff "Shops" Kit #0015

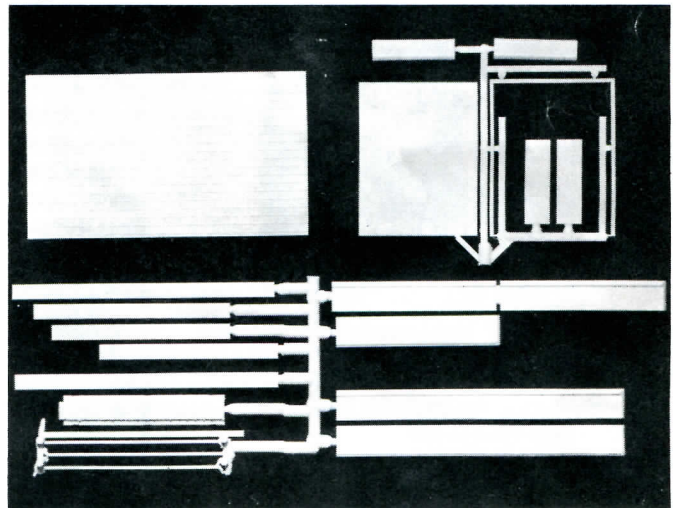


Before starting your Pikestuff "Shops" kit, take time to first gather the correct tools. We suggest an X-acto® hobby knife with a #11 and a #17 blade, a sheet of medium grit sandpaper, a small file or Emery board, liquid plastic cement, and a small brush to apply the cement. You will also need sheet styrene or balsa to build up the floor as shown in the in-

structions, and some 1/16" x 1/16" styrene or balsa stock for bracing. A tube of ACC (Alpha Cyanoacrylate Cement) is also a good idea.

Lay out all the sections of the kit and check them against the photos. **Figure 1.** shows the main wall sections. The top row shows the peaked front and back walls. We are only showing one of each

piece, but your kit has two of each piece. The second row shows three wall sections. Notice the rain gutter (the raised edge) at the top. There are three wall sections per kit with the gutter wrapping around the left end, three with the gutter wrapping around the right end, and four sections with no wrap-around. These four are the mid-wall sections. Take one
